

OFFICIAL BOARD
HIGHWAY MISSION TABERNACLE

Specially called meeting of the Official Board held on January 17, 1937, at the close of the morning service.

Opened with prayer by the Pastor.

(Majority of members present; Brothers Krause, Alexander, Carr, Payne, and one other member absent.)

The Pastor stated that he had been in conversation with Brother Owen Lee who had spoken briefly on the preceding Thursday evening, and who has felt a drawing to Philadelphia for some time, and believes the Lord has sent him to the city to be a blessing. He had anticipated holding services with Brother Benson, but finds that other arrangements have been made. The Pastor asked if the Board would be interested in having Brother Lee give a few days meetings at Highway.

After Discussion and consideration which brought us to no conclusion it was moved, seconded and carried that any decision be deferred until after the evening service.

The Pastor stated that he had been in conference with a young man in the Church who, for some time, had felt the call of God upon his heart to enter Missionary Service in the Gold Coast, but had deferred asking for recognition because of others who also felt called, but now he felt it imperative to make some move along this line, and accordingly he had written to Springfield for Missionary Application, and finds that he needs the approval of the Official Board and also his home Assembly. The Pastor stated that since tomorrow night was the Annual Meeting of the Church this young man might receive the approval of the Church if he were approved by the Board.

Moved by Brother McKittrick, seconded and carried, that the Official Board grant its full approval to Brother Norman Bullock.

There being no further business, on motion, the meeting adjourned.
