It was stated that inasmuch as the Church, at its last business meeting in had appointed two lay delegates to represent Highway at the Council Meeting to be held in Memphis, Tennessee, September 9 to 12th, 1937, and the Pastor, Brother Steelberg, having been notified that we were only allowed one delegate to represent the Church at the Council, this meeting was called to decide which of the two lay delegates appointed by the Church should receive credentials to the Council meeting.

Moved by Brother Hepworth, seconded by Brother Brosky, that Brother Charles Zell be chosen as the lay delegate to represent Highway at the Council meeting.

After some discussion, in which it was stated that the Pastor had felt that inasmuch as the office of a lay delegate would be that of ministry, and perhaps should be that of a deacon or elder, Brother Hepworth, with the consent of Brother Brodsky. withdrew his motion.

Moved by Brother Day, seconded by Brother Bell, and unanimously carried, that Brother Zell and Brother Carr decide between themselves as to which one should represent Highway at this Council meeting, and that a letter of credentials be given to the one so selected.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
