Brother Combs mentioned the fact that since the change of the Sunday School hour it seemed there had been a real sacrifice of time in the morning service. Brother Day said he would endeavor to close the Sunday School on time so they could start the morning service at 11 o'clock.

Brother Steelberg stated that while at the Council Meeting Brother Carter informed him that the best preacher in England, by the name of Jones, was coming to the States, arriving the first week in October, and we are having the first chance to have him at Highway if we want him, for the Thanksgiving Convention, and asked the Board to pray that the Lord will help and guide in this matter.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned with prayer by Brother Day.
