The meeting was opened with prayer.

It was stated that the Trustee Board had met concerning the Radio question, and they felt that under the circumstances the Church, as a Christian Body, should endeavor to hold to their contract with W.P.E.N., either by staying on the air for one hour at \$70 for the months of June, July and August, or for one-half hour at \$60, and that if there was not enough money available to pay the whole amount each week, that payments be made up in the fall.

Brother Krause stated that as he understood it Mr. Simon insinuated that we could

1 Continue with the Broadcast, fulfilling the contract,

2 Broadcast for the next three weeks at \$88. and

pay \$88. for the first three weeks in June and not broadcast, or

3 Give him a little gift and he would write a clause in the contract which could be broken on three weeks' notice.

After some discussion it was moved by Brother Joe McKittrick that Brother Charles Krause again visit Mr.Simon and get the best proposition he would make with reference to broadcasting for one hour and also for broadcasting for one-half hour, not paying more than \$55 for the half-hour, which was unanimously consented to.

Moved by Brother Wilson and seconded, that Brother Joe McKittrick have charge, together with others who have been assisting the Pastor, of the Radio Broadcast these two weeks while Brother Steelberg is away, which was agreed to. Moved and seconded that the meeting adjourn.
