

Whereas the Scripture clearly commands in Lu 14:23 "Go out into the Highways and hedges & compel them to come in" - and in view of the imminent coming of our Lord coupled with the realization that we can only reach the multitudes by definite Missionary work, therefore be it resolved that in harmony with our Manual provision Article 10 pertaining to Missionary Work - We create the Office of City Missionary or Missionaries and Inasmuch as definite experience on the part of persons now engaged in such Missionary Work prove the need of such an office and a definite Policy controlling it we suggest the following Outline of operation.

### 1. Selection of Missionaries

The Missionary shall be selected according to Spiritual & Physical qualifications adapted to all conditions involving upon a City Missionary - They may be suggested ~~to~~ ~~nominate~~ by Any department of the Church. The Pastor & Elders together with such Department heads as may be interested shall consider the Qualifications of applicants ~~and~~ and if felt advisable to approve shall submit the same to the Church at a business session for ratification.

### 2. Ministry of Missionaries

The Missionary shall apply them selves to a thorough study of the work involved and such methods approved by the Church & General Council procedure shall be utilized. All Missionaries being subject to the Pastor & Board of Elders in matters pertaining to their General Missionary Activity -

### 3. Support of Missionaries

City Missionaries shall be supported on the same basis as our Foreign Missionaries at the rate of \$50.00 per month minimum compensation being adjusted by circumstances applying to receipt of funds in the Church, The amount of service rendered and such conditions. The Board of Trustees together with the Board of Elders shall control these matters. Departmental contributions augmenting specific allowance by the Board shall be given to the Treasurer and disbursed by him over

### Reports

A Report of activities shall be rendered each Quarter to the Quarterly Meeting and Monthly reports may be rendered if deemed advisable.

Further—It is proposed that Foreign Missionaries supported by Highway Mission Tabernacle and delayed on furlough shall be requested after a reasonable allowance of time to be agreed upon by the Official Board to engage in such City Missionary activities as the Church shall prescribe—Their Monthly allowance being maintained at regular level in accordance with their co-operation.

When arrangements for return to foreign service are made and proper notification is given by the Missions Dept. that parties are permitted to return to a Fair amount of time shall be permitted for itineration such as the Missionary may desire.

Every reasonable allowance will be made for recuperation rest and adjustment before any requirements are made of our Foreign missionaries but prolonged furlough on full support without co-operation in City Missions activities is not consistent with good judgment.
