The meeting opened with prayer.

The Pastor stated the meeting had been called at the request of Sister Payne who had been requested to present a matter to the Board.

The Church Clerk read a letter which she had received from Sister Isabel McKittrick, dated February 16, 1942, with reference to the decision of the Board regarding the return of Brother and Sister Shirer from Africa.

Some discussion ensued and questions were asked in order to clear up the situation. Brother Thomas Griffith made a motion that we write to Springfield and get a record of the telegram sent by Brother Steelberg in answer to the telegram he received from them, etc., which motion was seconded, but later withdrawn.

Motion made by Brother Howard Fearn, seconded by Brother Tuttle, and carried, that the Official Board appoint the Board of Elders, together with the Pastor, to visit the McKittricks with regard to the decision of the Board concerning the Shirers' return, and report back to the Official Board.

Moved by Brother Walter Hepworth, seconded by Brother E. Day, and carried, that the Official Board appoint a committee to consider and edit the new manual which had been authorized by the church.
