

Meeting of the Official Board called by the Pastor, held on Tuesday evening, November 6, 1945, at the Church, at 7:30 P.M.

The Pastor, Rev. W. S. Bragg, presided.

The meeting was opened with prayer.

Bro. Bragg stated there were a few things that should be discussed with the Board, and he called on Brother Krause to read certain recommendations by the Board of Elders.

Brother Krause read a recommendation of the Board of Elders, That the balconies of the Church be reopened and that an effort be made to maintain order and reverence in the Church.

After some discussion the recommendation of the Board of Elders was accepted by acclamation.

Bro. Bragg stated that it was impossible for him to follow up those who seek the Lord at our altars, and those who would seek the Lord during the coming Revival meetings at the Metropolitan Opera House, and called on Bro. Krause to read a recommendation of the Board of Elders on this subject.

Bro. Krause read a recommendation from the Board of Elders, That the Board of Trustees ascertain what remuneration would be required by Sister Hughes to take up the work of an Assistant to the Pastor.

After some discussion, in which it was suggested that a trained worker should be sought, either from E.B.I. or C. B. I. to do this work, on motion of Brother Walter Hepworth, duly seconded and carried, the Pastor was given authority to look out a person to fill the position of Assistant to the Pastor.

Bro. Bragg brought up the question relating to the 1946 Missionary Convention and the 1945 Missionary Rally, as it was desirous to fix a date to be printed on the pledge envelopes.

The Missionary Rally was fixed for the third Sunday of December, 1945, and the Missionary Convention for 1946 be fixed for November 1st.

It was also suggested that the Elders should rotate in taking different positions in and about the Church and on the platform, so they may be in a place where they can help to main-

tain order and start the meetings on time.
