Meeting of the Official Board, called by Brother Krause, (Brother Bragg being on vacation, though he had been informed that a meeting would be called), immediately after the Sunday morning service on August 21, 1949, at the Church, 19th and Green Streets, Phila., Pa.

Present: Brother Charles Krause, presiding, C. Alexander, Walter Hepworth, Frank Simokat, I. Day, E. Day, A. Clarke, Fred Hepworth, C. McPherson, W. Hollohan, T. Griffith, and Brother George Waggoner; Sisters Griffin, Maude Nethery and C. Payne.

Brother Krause stated that the meeting had been called to discuss whether a speaker should be secured for a spring campaign, and also if the same speaker should be secured for tent meetings, as Brother Bragg was going to Council and it might be he could contact someone there, as no one as yet had been secured.

On motion made by Brother Walter Hepworth, duly seconded and carried, Brother Bragg was instructed to engage a speaker for the spring campaign only.

Bro. Geo. Waggoner made a statement that Mrs. Force, of Camden, who is unable to attend the services, but who sends her tithes, was not well. She wants to get in a home, and is willing to turn her property over to the church if this can be accomplished. At present she is back in her taxes and water rent to the amount of about \$50., and she was wondering whether she could get this from the Church until she could pay it back. This matter was turned over to the Board of Deacons and Deaconesses.
