The Minutes of the previous meeting, held June 24th, 1940 were approved as read, followed by the Treasurers report which was also accepted as read.

The Flower Committee did not have a report to submit in view of the fact that no flowers were distributed during their term. For the next six months Allen Hummell and Fred Hepworth were called upon to act on the new Flower Committee, and authorized to provide for flowers for the Young People's Rally and Thanksgiving Convention.

The Ushers Committee presented the name of Ernest Harris for membership into the association, who was duly voted upon and accepted.

Brother Elmer Day was appointed a committee of one to approach any prospective ushers who would be asked to be taken in as new members.

Immediately following the above order of business the meeting was thrown open for new business and general discussions. A suggestion was offered that in order to encourage folks entering the church to occupy seats closer to the front that a certain section of the church be roped off in the rear - say about 6 pews from the back. Bro. Geo. McKinley was appointed a committee of one to go further into this matter with the House Committee for the privilege of doing this, and securing sufficient rope and holders for this work.

Brother Elmer Day brought up the question of fire hazards in the church and the possibility and advisability of conducting fire drills in view of the seriousness of the situation in case of fire. Certain points how to overcome them in case of fire. Brother Day and Bro. Ernest Harris were delegated to look into this matter of fire hazards, and also to bring this to the attention of the Trustees.

As there was no further business to discuss the meeting closed with prayer.
