

January 25, 1955.

A general discussion as to the selling of the Parsonage after which it was moved and seconded that Bro Elmer Day contact the Real Estate man to appraise the property and report back to the Board, for further dispositive decision on the matter.

After much discussing in reference to the support of Bro Wm. Hawkes it was decided to give Bro Hawkes \$25.00 per week taking him on the payroll as of January 13. This is to continue until arrangements can be made with Bro Garfield and the Board to see if Bro Garfield is going to relinquish the support of Bro. Hawkes. at which time we may feel that we can raise the amount.

It was decided to economize in every way possible and the first step in the way, was that that the ad in the Inquirer be cut to at least one half the size. Also that the fountain in the Ladies Room be removed.

The question of the salary of an incoming Pastor was brought up and it was stated that the top for such would not exceed \$90. per week.

It was moved and seconded that a letter been written by the Secretary to the Boards of The Elders, and The Deacons concerning the clearing of the rooms and hallways and lobbies, during the Services in the Church. That also one of the Deacons should see that this is carried out.

It was also moved and seconded that An Official Board Meeting be called for the purpose of arranging the services etc, in Highway.
