

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was held
June 21, 1955.

Those present were Bro. Richard Ambrose,
Chas. Lee Pherson, Oscar Schmil, Tom Bufffith,
Bro. Robinson and Allen Sam.

The meeting was opened by prayer lead by Bro
Roberson.

In the absence of Bro. Day, the Treasurer's Report was
read by Bro. Ambrose.

Balance on hand in the general Fund was as of June 1, 1955
\$1325.44 - The building Fund \$1266.33 and the
Missionary \$3726.51

The House Committee requested that volunteer workers
be add for the painting of Sister Alexander's room.
Therefore it was regular moved and seconded (motion
by Bro. Day and seconded by C. McPherson) that we try to
get volunteers for this work as soon as possible.

The House Committee were authorized to obtain locks
for the back door. (Sister Alexander's room)

The House Committee stated that the Passmore
Kitchen should be painted. (Part of the wall to be tiled)

Bro. Schmil is to obtain the price for the doing of this
work. They were also to obtain a mover for the use
at the Passmore. As to keys for the Passmore they
were instructed to contact Sister Robinson as to the
colour etc.

Bro. Tom Bufffith was instructed to contact the
Cleanser of the Passmore as to possibility of a refund
on the price since they did not complete the job satisfactory.

Bro. Robinson requested that he would appreciate it if
members of the Trustee Board would help him buy some
furniture and that he (Bro. Robinson) would pay it
back - In other words a loan.

Bro. Robinson was requested that he contact Bro. Goffert
as to his position - of needing support from us.

Bro. Robinson - made the following suggestions -
- A Church Bulletin, & Radio Broadcast, also that
plans be incorporated for the relocation of the Church

and that a sound program for this project. He Bro
Petersen would obtain some facts for our consideration
from Broadway Plan of Financing. This organization
finances Church Building Programs.

It was suggested that we meet in the near future
to consider the building program with Bro Petersen
The meeting was adjourned by prayer
