

Trustee Meeting May 24th, 1968.

Members present: Tom Griffith Rev. Roberson Al Luff Dom Mariano

Meeting was opened with Bible reading and prayer.

The Secretary read the minutes and they were accepted as read.

The Treasurer read his report and they were accepted as read.

The House Committee reported as follows:

1. All outside doors need varnishing.
2. Blue spruce was cut off.
3. Trash needs tyding up.
4. No action on jack.

Bro Griffith moved that all outside doors be varnished and that a cellar jack be pruchased. Seconded by Daon - moved as read - House Committee authorized for action.

Carrier Air Conditioners tested - all units go.

Chalk boards need mounting, ranger unit volunteered for the job.

Miscellaneous discussions to numerous to record were as follows:
Outside sign, rangers, floors, fence, treasurer's report, water fountain rental and financial committee meeting - all no action.

Pastor suggested action be taken to raise our Church coverage to \$400,000.00 on the building only. Ambrose moved, Gerhart seconded - all concurred.

More general conversation, secretary complained - no action.

The Pastor reported that a station and native worker disqualified himself because of his actions and suggested we drop his support. All concurred.

Dan Bogden was voted \$25.00 as a love offering.

It was agreed by all that the Camacho's would be carried on the mission's payroll another sixty days.

The Pastor suggested we buy the piano from Carol Schmiel after an appraisal. Bro. Ambrose seconded and recommended that the Pastor have the piano appraise - report to the committee and then make an offer to purchase.

Bro. Griffith suggested that the congregation give a love offering towards the E. S. Williams Chapel, then evaluate it and bolster the giving if necessary.

Bro Griffith moved to adjourn, Dron seconded. We dismissed in prayer.
